Budget Review for 10/11 School Year

- Budget was reviewed and presented to Boosters
- No music teacher for 10/11 but will leave \$400 in place to be used for music
- Will remove fundraiser expenses out of budget and create separate balance sheet for 10/11
- Small adjustments made to assignment notebooks, outdoor program, Madison trip, teacher expense accounts, bus fees, special events and school marketing.
- Budget was approved at \$12,750 for 10/11.

Principals Report

- Class trip for Chicago is all set – May 11, 12, 13.
- Should be able to return money to Boosters due to fundraising efforts
- Carnival will be moved to January next year
- Net loss on carnival was estimated at -\$108.20. Reminder that this was not a money making event, but a way to market the school to families. Everyone was satisfied with the outcome.
- Will have a few less games and will eliminate Sumo wrestling
- Food worked well; pizza will be delivered hot next year
- Spent \$800 on advertising
- Golf outing
- 3 families toured the school during the carnival
- Left over items from carnival will be used for Kids Can Shop Too
- Last day of school is 6/4/10
- Events will take place starting at 11am, will have cookout, sporting events in the p.m.

New Business

- Idea to have a slideshow with pictures, tables with sports, music, student council and volunteer signup at back to school night.
