The Lady Eagles proved how much they have grown during the last official game of the 2010 basketball season. There was a rough start during the first half which could take some teams confidence level and playing level down, but not our Lady Eagles. During half time the coach made two requests. First, stop Trinity from scoring in the third quarter. Second, start putting Lady Eagle points on the scoreboard. Trinity was held to only two points in the third quarter vs. 20 points in the first half. Our Lady Eagles then added 14 points of their own in the second half. Even though we didn't come away with an official win (Trinity took the game by nine points with a final score of 24 to 33), in the coach's eyes the Lady Eagles take away a half a win by implementing all that was asked of them in the second half (proving that a game takes all four quarters). The last time the Lady Eagles faced Trinity Racine in January, we lost by 21 points. This time a win was within reach! Way to go Lady Eagles! Points were put up by better than 50% of our team (Lori Bakke - 9 points, Alley Smith - 7 points, Shelby Jacobs - 2 points, Cheyenne Pofahl - 2 points, Brittany Smith - 2 points, Rachel Szeklinski - 2 points). Remember that points are not the only measure of what you contribute. Rebounding, execution of the plays, and playing as a team is what

makes you successful!

**By the coach's calculations the regular season ended with 5 ½ wins to 4 ½ losses.** This record was achieved thru a team effort. Remember Lady Eagles, you get what you give. Your individual successes are measured by the commitment you give the team. This is a great lesson to carry with you throughout life, the more you commit....the more you will receive.
