



ST. PETER'S BOOSTER ASSOCIATION MINUTES

November 10, 2008

OPENING PRAYER: Principal Dopke opened the meeting with prayer. APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion to accept minutes made by Wendy Cain; seconded by Michelle Ciezki. Minutes accepted unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT: LuAnn Himebauch summarized report indicating the balance remaining in Money Market is \$18,417.32.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Principal Dopke commented that the recent booster tailgate party was a lot of fun and everyone enjoyed it. Also, he is continuing to work on making White Boards.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

TOUR OF HOMES, COOKIE WALK: Kim Leinweber updated Boosters on cookie walk. Discussion was had regarding what was done in the past as far as setup and volunteers. Further discussion was had regarding new form to distribute for sign up for one-hour shifts.

Garland Decorating for Cookie Walk-- Discussion had regarding each classroom decorating a garland for Tour of Homes. Wendy Cain indicated that there is plenty of Garland and if the teachers need more, to let Boosters know. Mrs. Fish commented that not many people would go downstairs, or may have hard to time getting up and down the steps. Mrs. Fish suggested instead of decorating classroom windows/doors doing something else to go along with the Garland. Wendy Cain suggested having

each child write What the School Means to Me and displaying that next to each classroom Garland. Further discussion was about whether children will sing during Tour of Homes.

KIDS CAN SHOP TOO: Wendy Cain updated Boosters that donations have been coming in. Debi Maurer informed that the form was sent out for signing up to those that expressed an interest and two have come back. Ms. Maurer will send another form out this week.

MANUALS FOR FUNDRAISERS: Kim Leinweber informed that the folders are all ready and are in Debi Maurer's office. Debit Maurer will get them to Mark Somers to make a manual. President Ciezki suggested putting notes next to each committee on what worked and what didn't work.

NEW BUSINESS:

Results of the tailgate party: Wendy Cain indicated that the Tailgate party was a success and suggested doing another tailgate in spring for the end-of-the year basketball game.

Boosters Request Form: President Ciezki suggested Boosters put together a form to request any expenses from Boosters as a way to improve communication. The form would include who is requesting, where the money will go, and the amount being requested. Discussion was had regarding putting on the form whether other payments are being made, such as matching or partially funding put on form. Also, putting on project time line in order to budget appropriately. Further discussion had. President Ciezki will put together a sample form and email it out.

Digital Camera: Kim Leinweber indicated that the school digital camera is broken and cannot be returned. Ms. Leinweber requested Boosters to cover the expense of a new digital camera. Peter Lorenz does use the pictures for the Yearbook and other events. Discussion was had regarding using funds from Technology Budget. Motion made by President Ciezki to disburse the money necessary from the Technology Budget to cover the expense of a new digital camera. Seconded by Wendy Cain. Motion passed unanimously.

UPCOMING EVENTS: Movie Night - Discussion was had regarding having a movie night. President Ciezki indicated that in the past he heard that kids

were dropped off or kids were running around. Perhaps indicating that a child must be accompanied by an adult. Ms. Fish suggested changing the name to "Family Movie Night". Also, Boosters will provide popcorn and drinks, and families can bring a snack if they wish. Further discussion was had regarding which movie to show. Wendy Cain suggested voting. Family Movie Night is scheduled for November 21st, 2008 at 6:30 p.m.

Nancy Szeklinski suggested Skating at Traxside in December. Tim Szeklinski can donate tickets for admission to help offset expenses for Boosters.
