Current News:

- **Carnival** –
 - Planning is underway
 - Fun Services will come in on 1/13/11 to help us select games and provide general assistance with room measurement, etc.
 - Event will take place from 11am – 3pm.
 - Discussion around ticket prices and face painting. Goal is to get people in, not fundraise, so will consider that when making those decisions.
 - Sarah will lead the concessions, which will include hot dogs, frozen pizza, ice cream sandwiches, nachos, soda and water.
 - Discussion around advertising costs. Again, goal is to market to young families so decision was made to spend similar to what was spent last year. Will also advertise the preschool change in the ads. Flyers for businesses will be created and church yard sign will be put up. Chamber window is a possibility.
 - Signup sheets will go out this week for all help needed.

- **Spaghetti Dinner**
 - Donation letters will go out at end of January
 - Thrivent matching funds and money raised will go toward music and foreign language programs.
 - Mike will handle cataloging and numbering donations
- **Community Night – Internet Safety**
