- Expenses were \$3,292.29

- Money Market balance is \$12,589.73
- Check book balance as of 2/9/11 is \$438.68
- Reviewed 2010 Annual Report
- Carnival review – Income was \$708.22
- Expenses for carnival (not final) \$1,386.21
- Event was not intended to raise funds, but promote the school and attract new families.
