Treasurer's Report:

- LuAnn reviewed treasurer's report through 4/5/2011. Expenses were \$9,005.76
- Money Market balance is \$10,891.96
- Check book balance as of 4/5/2011 is \$423.12
- Final numbers are in on the carnival – total income \$733.22
- Total expenses \$2,226.48
- Net loss was -\$1,493.26
- Carnival was not intended to be profitable, but rather to attract families to the school.

Principals Report: -

- 2011/12 school calendar has been drafted.
- No change to start and end times
- Christmas and Spring Musical will be combined
- No change to Christmas vacation schedule
- Reviewing new lunch program – Quality Catering for Kids. Will have complimentary lunch 4/14 to sample. Healthier foods is the goal.
- Boosters will not sponsor Lutheran School Night at Miller Park
- Boosters will pay bill from Comsifter - \$239. All computer issues are resolved. A piece of hardware was needed. May hire someone to look at systems over summer to see what is needed for next year.

Pastor/Teacher/School Board Report: -

- Spaghetti Dinner went well
- Tentative income \$7,966.00
- Expenses \$1586.15 (prior to pre-school adjustments)
- Profit approximately \$6,379.85.
- Final numbers will be posted at May meeting.
- School baskets provided \$560 in income

- Adjustments made to expenses to contribute to pre-school.K-3, K-4 Preschool Full Day Program was presented at Forum meetings. The program is set to begin starting in September of 2011.
- Next year will start earlier and use different approach for gathering donations. Otherwise, it's the same few people doing it. May utilize a family style approach.

New Business:

- Teacher Appreciation week is week of May 2nd. Parents will watch kids during lunch to provide lunch time to teachers. Parents will be asked to bring a dessert. Terry will check on catering.
- Talent Show Dress Rehearsal – Will invite seniors to dress rehearsal. Boosters will cover the senior lunch cost on either 5/4 or 5/5. Parents can also be in talent show if desired.
- Golf outing – tentative schedule:
 - May 15th, 2011
 - 1:30pm check in, putting contest, raffles
 - 3:00pm shotgun start for 9 hole scramble
 - 5:30pm appetizers, pizza and cash bar
 - 6:30pm bucket raffle drawings and live auction
 - Jim and Jackie will put up flyers around town on 4/14/11
 - Actual cost per golfer is \$32.34, mark up to \$45 per golfer and \$15 for those who are not golfing, but enjoying food and fellowship
 - Will be in church bulletin 4/13 and 4/17.
 - Rivermoor will add golfers to email list
 - Hole sponsorship will be \$100
 - Will need volunteers for registration table, raffle ticket sales prior and post, putting contest, awards, live auction (2).
 - Each golfer will get \$5 Pro Shop credit.
 - Rivermoor will donate a round of golf and a cart to the event and will be auctioned off
 - Putting contest prize will be half the pot \$5 per person
- Defibrillator needs new pads and battery. Will discuss how to pay with church and school board.
